Philanthropic Project Chair

- Solicit ideas for philanthropic projects from chapter members
- Arrange meetings with representatives of prospective recipient agencies
 - Send out an RFP (UNF Chapter has document)
- Prepare tentative budget
- Prepare informational materials for chapter members
- Motivate the chapter
