



DESIGNATIONS BESTOWED:

FAFP Distinguished Fellow

HonFAFP Honorary Fellow (for those who are not members of AFP)

CRITERIA FOR NOMINATIONS:

Submissions can be received from:

- Chapters
- Individuals
- Current AFP Distinguished or Honorary Fellows
- Self-nomination is not allowed

Eligibilty

- AFP Global members currently serving on either the AFP Board, AFP US Foundation for Philanthropy, Canada Foundation Board, or the AFP Canada Board are ineligible to apply.
- AFP members must have ten or more years in the profession.
- Nonmembers must have ten or more years in leadership.
- A nomination can be submitted annually. If not accepted, nomination can be resubmitted a
 maximum of three times.

Nominations Form Requires

- Application available on afpglobal.org
- Nominator's and nominee's name
- Letter of Recommendation (not from Nominator)
- Information on the nominee including:
 - Professional recognition
 - Employment history
 - Publications and speaking history
 - Professional association membership years, honors and activity
 - 1000-word citation
 - Concise and accurate description of the contributions of the nominee describing why he/she should be elected
 - Collection of data on areas of expertise for future engagement

SELECTION COMMITTEE:

- Comprised of Alternates to the AFP Nominating Committee
- If the alternate moves into the representative role, then the District Committee member would serve on this committee
- Immediate Past Chair of the AFP Global Board serves as Chair of the committee
- Immediate Past Chairs of AFP Canada, AFP Foundations for Philanthropy (US & Canada) will sit on the committee as members
- Each nomination is evaluated by the Selection Committee
- Notify chapters of nominees before finalization
- Timeline Please see appendix
- Class size determined annually

RECOGNITION:

- AFP website
- Profile article in Advancing Philanthropy magazine
- Fellows recognition at AFP ICON
- Award bestowed for life. If someone is no longer a member of AFP, they will automatically become an Honorary Fellow

ONGOING ENGAGEMENT:

- Communications from AFP Global
 - Fellows may write articles for Advancing Philanthropy magazine, AFP Perspectives, participate in educational/career panels, or record videos on behalf of AFP Global.
- Fellows must commit to engaging in one of these areas:
 - Get involved in advocacy efforts with AFP
 - Be an online mentor or a chapter mentor
 - Give to the AFP Foundation(s)
