

## Fundraising Expectations for 2020




#### Increasing Fundraising Activity in 2020?

 38% of charities will increase their fundraising activity in 2020 because of COVID-19



• **39%** will keep their fundraising at normal levels

# What Kind of Fundraising is Increasing in 2020

88%: donor retention and stewardship

83%: social media

81%: virtual events

79%: online fundraising

71%: email



## Coronavirus Response Survey— Canada Findings (continued)

### Government Funding



- 44% of respondents applied to the Canada Emergency Wage Subsidy program, and 23% received funding.
- Approximately 15% applied to the Canada Emergency Business Account/Loan, the Emergency Community Support Fund, and/ or Canada Emergency Response Benefit Fund: and roughly 6% receiving any funding.

## **Working from Home**

 93% indicated they are working from home now



 77% say their organization was "well or "somewhat" prepared for the shift to working from home

### **Cancelling Special Events**

 76% have had to cancel at least one event



• **55%** have switched at least one in-person event to a virtual event

### Layoffs/Pay Cuts

**31%** of organizations have been forced to lay off staff



- **31%** of charities have instituted furloughs
- 18% of organizations have cut staff pay
