

Role of the AFP Ethics Committee

Through the AFP Ethics Committee AFP promotes responsible and ethical behavior by its members and those holding AFP certification.

The committee encourages AFP chapters to form ethics education committees and to offer chapter-led workshops using ethics education materials developed and sanctioned by AFP. Committee members also offer ethics workshops during AFP's annual conference and are available to deliver ethics education programs at no cost to chapters. Any questions regarding interpretation of the *Code* should be addressed to the Ethics Committee through the AFP President's office.

The Committee's enforcement procedures provide a process for receiving, investigating and adjudicating allegations of *Code* violations. AFP members are held to the *Code*, as are persons holding an AFP-sanctioned credential. The objective is to engage in a process that is fair, responsible and confidential.
